What is soundpainting?



Soundpainting is a "sign language" that allows you to compose in front of a live audience. A soundpainter uses signs and gestures in order to communicate and to tell musicians what they could, should or must do!



During the $20^{\rm th}$ century there has been a lot of experiments with all sorts of alternative ways to make music.



Soundpainting is not only one of the most successful alternative ways to make music, it is also highly entertaining!

Soundpainting was invented in the seventies by the American composer Walter Thompson. Since then, it has turned into a multidisciplinary language shared by actors, dancers and even visual artists.





What are we going to do?

During the project week, you will be immersed in the language of soundpainting. Each day, we learn new gestures and signs. As a singer or a musician, you will learn how to perform. But you will also be a soundpainter yourself, who creates and composes in front of a live audience. And who knows, you might even have to dance and perform as an actor ...
